Homer Learning Models

A group of school and community stakeholders were brought together to form a School Reopening Team. The mission of the team was to develop a comprehensive plan to direct the reopening of our schools that will best provide for the health, safety and wellness of students, staff, and the community, while ensuring the delivery of a quality education to students at all grade levels.

After reviewing guidance from the New York State Department of Health, and the New York State Education Department, we are planning for the following learning model(s) for this fall.

Learning Models

Pre-K - 6

- **In-person learning**
 - Five days per week. This includes all Special Education students and English Language Learners.
- **Home Learning**
 - Five days per week for students whose families choose this model for a minimum of ten weeks.

Grades 7-12

- **Hybrid Learning**
 - **Hybrid Learning Group 1** - Attend in-person on Monday and Tuesday; Home Learning on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.
 - **Hybrid Learning Group 2** - Attend in-person Thursday and Friday, Home learning on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.
 - **Hybrid Learning Group 3** - Attend in-person four instructional days and participate in Home Learning on Wednesday. English Language Learners and Students with Disabilities with inclusive programming as a part of their Individual Education Plans (IEPs) will be in this group.
- **Home Learning**
 - Five days per week for students whose families choose this model for a minimum of ten weeks.
- **In-Person Learning**
 - Students with disabilities that are NYSAA eligible attend in-person learning five days per week. District personnel will contact families with eligible students.

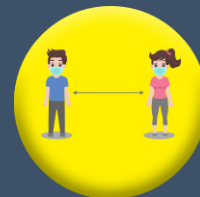
In Order to Reopen All NYS Schools Must:

Grades 7-12 (Hybrid Learning 1) <i>Attend in-person on Monday and Tuesday; Home Learning on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.</i>					
Grades 7-12 (Hybrid Learning 2) <i>Attend in-person on Thursday and Friday; Home Learning on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.</i>					
Grades 7-12 (Hybrid Learning 3) <i>English Language Learners and Students with Disabilities with IEPs will be in this group.</i>					
Grades 7-12 (Home Learning) <i>Five days per week for students whose families choose this model for a minimum of ten weeks.</i>					
Grades 7-12 (In-Person) <i>Students with disabilities that are NYSAA eligible. District personnel will contact families with eligible students.</i>
